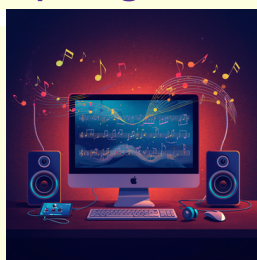
- **Decimals A**

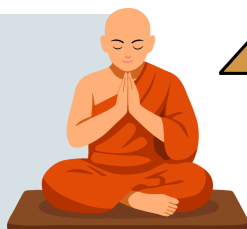

Buddhism

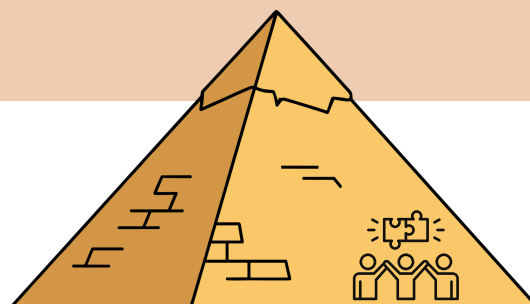
- **Theme:** The Eightfold Path

- Looking ahead.

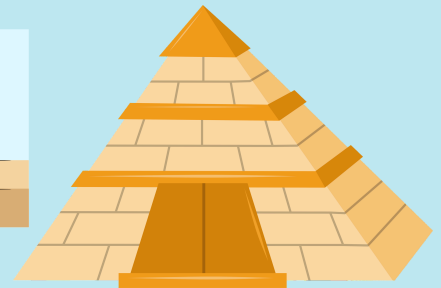
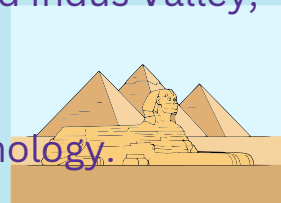


History
